Morning presentation. *Creative Techniques* – Recognizing the visual potential of an image is important to your creativity. This section will explore the creation of unique images that reflect the passage of time using time-lapse and multiple exposure techniques.

Long Exposure Creativity – The use of neutral density filters, motion, such as crashing waves or busy walkways, can be controlled with these filters allowing you to create expressive, fine-art imagery.

Afternoon Presentation. *Infrared: The World of Invisible Light* – Capture the surreal qualities of infrared light with your digital camera and create stunning images. You'll learn the essentials for utilizing infrared light for beautiful landscapes, portraits and still life imagery.

Artistic Imagery – Expand your techniques through the use of plug-ins, filters, and texture blending techniques with before and after illustrations of photographic interpretation. You'll learn how to use the tools of your craft and your own endless imagination to turn your photography into art.

Rt. 72 East exit #9 (Rt. 71 Main Street): Take a right at the end of the ramp onto Rt. 71 (Harry S. Truman Overpass), turn right at 1st light onto Chestnut Street. Trinity-on-Main is at intersection of Chestnut and Main. (Parking garage is on the right)
